

Assistant Professor Business

Academic Rank: Assistant Professor (tenure track). Highly qualified candidates may be considered at higher rank.

Deadline: September 30, 2010 or when filled

Starting Date: July 1, 2011

Institutional Requirements: To be considered for appointment, the candidate must wholeheartedly endorse the Mission Statement and the Statement of Faith of the University College (see <http://www.kingsu.ca/about-us/>). The successful candidate must have graduate level course work in the areas of teaching. A Ph.D. in business or a closely related field is preferred for tenure track appointment. Consideration will be given to applicants with an MBA (or similar) degree, especially if augmented by professional certification and/or business experience.

Teaching Load: Six term courses or equivalent per year.

Professional Duties: All tenure-track faculty members serve the community in various ways out of their expertise and share in faculty administration.

Particulars of the Position:

The successful candidate will be broadly educated, with a PhD or masters degree, and have teaching as well as professional experience in business. Preference will be given to candidates with expertise in one or more of the following: small business, entrepreneurship, finance and financial management, accounting. Ability to teach statistics, business law, labour relations, international business, or globalization would be an asset. Other duties include student advising. Candidates should specify what specific contributions they could make to a growing Business program, and their interest in team-teaching or professional projects. Candidates will be expected to engage in a program of research which may include professional consulting. The position offers flexibility in combining professional activities with responsibilities for teaching and scholarship. Candidates are expected to develop and articulate a Christian perspective on business, addressing the role that beliefs have in shaping its theory and practice. The successful candidate will be committed to a faith-based and interdisciplinary approach to education in a Christian liberal arts university college.

The King's University College is a Christian liberal arts university college offering three and four-year Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor of Science degrees, a Bachelor of Commerce, a Bachelor of Music, and a two-year after-degree Bachelor of Education (Elementary & Secondary) accredited by the province of Alberta.
