Chair, Board of Governors

## A Year in Review

### President's Message

In May 2010, our Board of Governors adopted a statement on *Strategic Direction 2010-2015*. The goal at the heart of this document is: *The King's University College will cultivate vibrant relationships of mutual service, particularly with **Christian communities in Alberta, Canada and internationally, and thereby claim and expand its niche in post-secondary education and contribute to society through program development, research engagement and other activities that embody our identity as an academic community of shalom.*** This goal affirms that King's cannot fulfil its mission in isolation. The lifeblood of a Christian university is found in its relationships with Christian communities that live out of the conviction that our world belongs to God and that one day God will make all things new in Christ. In the words of our Board Chair, **"the community that is King's is truly a gift from God, in service to God."**

### Spring Convocation

An event that embodies the essence of this relationship is our annual Spring Convocation. In late April, 147 graduates, along with their families, celebrated the successful completion of their university degree programs at King's. Each year, I take the opportunity to remind our graduates that they have been accompanied on their educational journey by a 'cloud of witnesses' – the large King's family that shares our Christian educational vision and prays for and pays for our academic community from day to day and year to year. On behalf of this year's graduates, thank you for your vision, dedication and support!

### First Graduates

This spring the first cohort of students graduated from the Secondary Education program launched in 2009. We trust that these graduates will be strong ambassadors for King's as they fan out to pursue their vocation in various communities.

### Knowledge Infrastructure Program (KIP)

We are thankful for and excited about many things that happened at King's over the past year.

Significant renovations of our campus, made possible in part by the Knowledge Infrastructure Program (KIP), the federal government's economic stimulus program for universities and colleges, have been completed. Faculty and students are benefiting from new science labs and improved library facilities. Important student services (Student Life, Registry, Enrolment Services) are now grouped together in a central 'mall,' and access to the Student Activities Centre is much improved. We discovered that a new hallway can be more than a hallway – it not only changes the 'traffic flow' but also contributes wonderfully to people's interaction. We're grateful for the many special gifts we have received in support of the KIP project and continue our work to raise a total of \$1 million to support these capital improvements.

### New Faculty and Faculty Accomplishments

In the academic arena, King's has also been richly blessed, particularly in the area of faculty recruitment. In 2010-2011, we welcomed new faculty members in Education and Psychology. In September, we will have the required full complement of three professors in Computing Science for the first time! New professors in Economics and Commerce will also join our team. We stand in awe of God's provision of a new generation of

academic leaders to carry King's mission forward. Our faculty members also continue to make significant contributions to their fields of study, with many publications and successful research projects in the past year.

### Financial Results

The 2010-2011 financial results included in this report are, frankly, a cause for concern. King's ended the fiscal year on March 31, 2011, with an operating deficit of \$740,000. This stands in sharp contrast to the modest surplus of \$145,000 King's achieved in the preceding fiscal year. Although donation revenue increased compared to 2009-2010, the final result was still significantly below the budgeted amount. Combined with a freeze in government grants (at 2009 levels) and slower than expected enrolment growth, this has created financial strain. We continue to work diligently to control costs without affecting the quality of our educational offerings during a time of economic instability. Notably, faculty and staff have shown their dedication and commitment to King's and its mission by agreeing to a number of unpaid furlough days during the coming year to help King's manage our financial challenges.

### Future Direction

The 2011-2012 fiscal year will bring significant challenges. We will continue working hard to build on last year's increase in donation support and strive to attain the budgeted targets for donations in this fiscal year. We are projecting an operating shortfall of \$105,000 in 2011-2012, and a return to a balanced budget in 2013-2014. Clearly we need to continue to increase enrolment and expand support in order to secure the future of our critically important educational mission. To that end, the Board of Governors commissioned an external management consultant to make recommendations regarding steps that need to be taken to achieve our strategic enrolment and fiscal goals. The Board endorsed the consultant's key recommendations, including the appointment of a Vice President for Institutional Advancement with responsibility for enrolment development, fund development and marketing. Steps are underway to implement this and other key recommendations.


### Excellent University Experience

While last year's fiscal bottom line was not what we hoped for, the overall institutional 'bottom line' reveals many reasons to give thanks to God: King's continues to provide students with an excellent university experience; our faculty are fully engaged with our mission in their teaching and their scholarship; and our administrative staff members, too, share a commitment to the mission of King's.

As noted by our Board Chair, we are deeply grateful for the vision and commitment of the King's community. It is indeed a privilege to serve on your behalf in honour of the King for whom our University is named.

### Knowledge Infrastructure Program

For the first time in our history, The King's University College was able to benefit from federal government capital funding. In August 2009, we received approval of a \$950,000 government grant to help fund \$1.9 million in capital projects to enhance our research capacity. All work that was initiated under the Knowledge Infrastructure Program wrapped up in March 2011 and resulted in some impressive changes that were well received by students, faculty and staff.

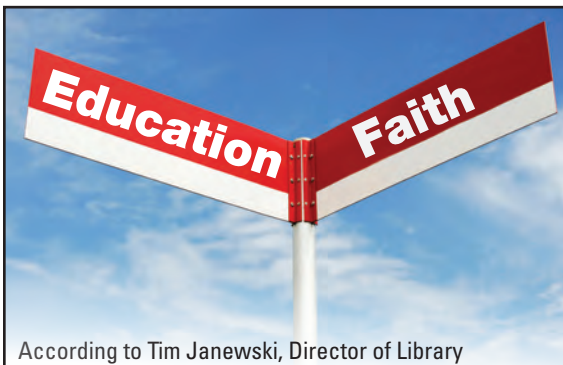




# The King's University College Foundation

Highlights of the Past Year

- In September 2010, King's made it a priority to provide the Foundation with its own dedicated office with all the necessary furnishings to make the office a pleasant and efficient work environment.
- At their meeting on April 15, 2011, the Directors of the Foundation approved a new brochure that will be used for new membership recruitment as well as explaining the purpose and vision of the Foundation.

**Retirement Savings Plan** - Supporters of King's who open RRSPs in The King's Group Registered Retirement Savings Plan can work toward their retirement goals while supporting The King's University College. The King's Group RRSP is principally invested in the campus property mortgage. The proceeds are used primarily to fund campus facilities. Interest is earned quarterly.

By investing in any of these programs, individuals play a role in the future success of students.
