Job Title:

Community Life Leader (CLL)

Accountability:

To the Associate Residence Director

Position Summary:

As part of the Community Life Team, the Community Life Leader is expected to offer support and leadership to other students within the apartments. Their role is to develop and implement programs that will lend themselves to holistic development among group members. (Spiritual/Relational programs). CLL's will be in charge of a group of 12-15 residents selected from all floors. They are to work alongside the Associate Residence Director to build a sense of community within the Apartment Residence. The Community Life Leader will work approximately 5 hours per week and maintain availability to all residents. This is a live-in position.

Characteristic Responsibilities:

Engaging

- Welcome students by participating in move-in and orientation events.
- Be present at Residence Life Team meetings as required
- Be a visible presence at Residence events, on their floor and in the King's community
- Work closely with Apartment Council and CLL specialists to carry out engagement opportunities in residence

Belonging

- Provide Christ-focused leadership, positive role modelling, support, and direction for residents as required. Be available to listen, counsel, refer, and advise residents within the limits of his/her training
- Develop one-on-one relationships with residents in their student group which are fostered by regular interaction

Learning

- Attend regular Residence Life Team meetings
- Attend all training events as required
- Be familiar with the regulations, policies and procedures of King's as described in the Student Handbook, and their rationale.
- Assist students through personal growth opportunities

Ownership

- Work together with the Worship Coordinator and other CLLs to assist Apartment students in planning at least one Worship 9:37 event per semester
- Take leadership in one CLL Specialist role (Ministry, Administration or Event Planning) as decided upon cooperatively with the Associate Residence Director
- Empower students with leadership responsibilities according to their abilities, personalities and desires

Academic Qualifications:

- Minimum GPA of 2.0 obtained before and maintained throughout term of position
- Must be registered full time in at least their second academic year at King's throughout term of position

Professional Qualifications:

- Proven ability to develop strong interpersonal relationships
- Proven ability to respond calmly and confidently in crisis situations
- Proven ability to communicate effectively and remain organized
- Confidence in leading large groups of students
- Experience working with young people and peers
- Experience living in residence
- Self-motivated

Personal Qualifications:

- Committed to and growing in their Christian faith
- Demonstrated commitment to King's community values
