Position Summary:

The Worship Assistant is a mature Christian demonstrating leadership abilities and committed to the Faith and Mission Statements of The King's University College. The Worship Assistant will work alongside the Campus Minister to plan and organize weekly campus worship services. This person will assist in identifying student worship leaders and coordinating the student worship teams. The Worship Assistant will meet regularly with the Campus Minister to guide, direct, and facilitate the structure of campus worship.

Characteristic Responsibilities:

Engaging

- Welcome residents by participating in orientation worship events.
- Meet regularly with musicians and worship team leaders for social and spiritual support.
- Be a visible presence at King's worship events, including chapel and Worship 937.
- Engage in other areas of campus worship that fit your own interests and gifts.

Belonging

- Provide Christ-focused leadership, positive role modelling, support, and direction for musicians as required. Be available to listen, counsel, refer, and advise musicians within the limits of his/her training.
- Develop one-on-one relationships with worship team leaders, fostered by regular interaction.
- Help facilitate and lead regular worship formation team meetings.

Learning

- Meet regularly with the Campus Minister to discuss and plan campus worship events.
- Attend the worship team retreat and other training events as required.
- Learn to assist worship team leaders/members in their personal growth and development as worship leaders.

Ownership

- Pursue personal growth in the ministry areas of your own interest with the guidance of the Campus Minister.
- Help shape the future trajectory of worship at King's
- Empower worship team leaders with leadership responsibilities according to their abilities, personalities and desires.

Academic Qualifications:

- Minimum GPA of 2.0 obtained before and maintained throughout term of position
- Must be registered in at least their second academic year at King's throughout term of position

- Experience leading worship groups; musical ability is an asset but not required.
