Position Summary:

A Worship Team Leader is responsible to oversee a worship team and help plan and lead worship for Chapel and Worship 937 on a regular basis. Team leaders help cultivate good team relationships, encourage spiritual growth, and facilitate growth in worship leadership among team members.

Characteristic Duties:

Engaging

- Actively participate in the worship life of the King's community
- Help plan and lead worship on campus that meets students, staff, and faculty where they are and draws them into a deeper experience and understanding of worship

Belonging

- Meet with other worship team leaders throughout the semester for prayer, encouragement, and fellowship
- Create opportunities for your team to develop strong relationships with each other, both in and out of rehearsals.
- Help foster an atmosphere of hospitality and welcome at worship gatherings on campus
- Encourage others in the student body to participate in weekly worship opportunities

Learning

- Meet regularly with Student Worship Assistant and/or the Campus Minister for mentoring
- Attend worship training events as the opportunities arise
- Participate in dialogues and book discussions on worship theology and worship leadership skills throughout the year
- Attempt to discover and appreciate the nuances of leading worship in a diverse academic community

Ownership

- Organize and lead regular team rehearsals
- With your team, lead worship in Chapel and Worship 937 one to two times per month
- Attend and contribute weekly to Worship Formation Team meetings to help plan chapel
- Communicate with Ministry Coordinators to help select music for 937

- A mature Christian who is growing in faith and has a passion for worship
- Experience leading worship through music

- Strong interpersonal relationship skills
- Organized
- Able to lead team meetings/rehearsals
- Must have at least second-year standing and be registered as a TKUC student
