

## Bequest Wording for The King's University

Below is general wording for a gift that is undesignated.

- “I give, devise, and bequeath to The King's University located in Edmonton, Alberta and bearing registration number 108085911RR0001 \_\_\_\_\_ (dollar amount or gift of property or portion of the residue) to be used in such manner as The King's University may direct.”

Donors may wish to choose a designation for their gifts. \*

- “I give, devise, and bequeath to The King's University located in Edmonton, Alberta and bearing registration number 108085911RR0001 \_\_\_\_\_ (dollar amount or gift of property or portion of the residue) to be used for the purpose of \_\_\_\_\_. (student awards, priority needs for program or faculties, capital projects, equipment, etc.)

Donors may wish to establish an endowment \*\* for a specified purpose.

- “I give, devise, and bequeath to The King's University located in Edmonton, Alberta and bearing registration number 108085911RR0001 \_\_\_\_\_ (dollar amount or gift of property or portion of the residue) to be invested as the Board of Governors sees fit for the purpose of funding an endowed \_\_\_\_\_ (scholarship, professorship, or chair), which will be known as the \_\_\_\_\_ (award, professorship, or chair) in \_\_\_\_\_ (faculty, department, or field of study).”

After the above clause, the following wording is requested:

“At some future time, it may be impractical to continue to use investment earnings from the endowment for the designated purpose. Under such circumstances, The King's University may re-designate the purpose of the endowment provided that the Fund shall continue to bear the name **XXX** and the amended terms shall adhere as closely as possible to the principal donors' intent in establishing the endowment.

The receipt of the gift by the proper agent of The King's University shall be sufficient discharge and, therefore, my Trustee shall be under no obligation to see that the trusts thereof are carried out.

\* When donors would like to designate gifts in their Will to a specific area or cause within The King's University, we encourage those donors or legal representatives to consult with a member of the Fund Development team to ensure that The King's University understands those wishes and can carry them out.

\*\* From time to time, The King's University sets minimum amounts to establish an endowment. Donors or their legal representatives are encouraged to consult Fund



Development staff to discuss these thresholds and so The King's University understands the intention of the endowment.
