

Worship Assistant

Position Summary:

Worship Assistants serve the King's community by helping to plan, organize and lead our regular times of communal worship. As a member of the Community Life Team, the Worship Assistant will assist in identifying student worship leaders and the assembly of our worship teams. He or she will meet weekly with the Worship Formation Team to guide, direct, and facilitate campus worship. The Worship Assistant will work approximately 5 hours per week.

Qualifications for all Student Leader positions:

- Open and willing to serving within a Christian context
- Support the King's mission and vision as well as demonstrate a commitment to King's community values
- Maintain a current and cumulative GPA of 2.5 or above
- Registered in at least your second academic year at King's throughout term of position

Specific Qualifications for Worship Assistant:

- Excited about growing in their Christian Faith
- Passionate about communal Christian worship
- Excited about getting members of our community (faculty/staff/students) involved in worship
- Ability to communicate effectively and work well on a team
- Ability to balance one's commitments (school/social/work) well
- Ability to create enthusiasm around Student Life and/or Campus Ministry events

Responsibilities:

- Attend orientation to welcome incoming students to King's
- Attend weekly Worship Formation Team meetings
- Attend Chapel
- Be the point person for particular Chapel services- bringing your ideas to the Worship Formation Team
- In collaboration with others, plan and lead our Chapel worship services
- Support others on the ministry team in their work.
- Stay current with COVID guidelines

Expectations for all Student Leader positions:

- Serve as a role model by demonstrating integrity inside and outside of the classroom
- Demonstrate ability to develop strong interpersonal relationships
- Set an example for what a successful student looks like by living with integrity, participating in activities throughout the year, and contributing to King's community life
- Demonstrate sensitivity toward diversity issues through friendship and advocacy for students.



- Have a working knowledge of and abide by the regulations, policies, and procedures of King's as described in the Student Handbook and Community Living Standards

Compensation:

- Worship Assistants will be paid \$950 divided semi-monthly for the duration of the contract. Payment is processed through King's payroll
