#### **POSITION SUMMARY**

Under the supervision of the Building Operator, the Maintenance Technician Assistant will be responsible for assisting in special maintenance projects and the day-to-day maintenance of the building, furniture, and equipment of the University's 270,000 sq. ft. campus.

### KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Replace stained and damaged ceiling tiles
- Reglue and affix baseboards
- Minor furniture maintenance (such as table lets, damaged table tops, chair screws etc.)
- Grease / Lubricate squeaky doors and door hardware
- Remove Garbage or refuse from the roof
- Keep the shop area organized and parts itemised
- Unplug toilets and other minor plumbing repairs
- Clean roof drains, cleaning of sky lights, solar panels etc.
- Small drywall repair in approved non-ACM containing locations
- Change out light tubes or bulbs
- Clean and maintain mechanical rooms
- Itemize and keep inventory of belts and filter, and assist with changing when shown how or where
- Painting
- Snow Removal of side walks and ice treatment
- General waster and junk removal
- Room checks (COVID Toilet flushing etc.)

- Experience and knowledge in building maintenance practices and techniques.
- Skill in care and use of tools and hazardous chemicals
- Minimum grade 8 education. Grade 12 preferred
- Ability to perform routine tasks requiring some manual dexterity; from light to heavy physical exertion.
- Ability to take initiative and work without direct supervision.
- Some work experience in a commercial, institutional, or industrial setting is required
- Ability to communicate effectively and work cooperatively with students, staff and the public
