

ADVANCED STANDING WITH CREDIT

REGENT COLLEGE ADMISSIONS POLICY



Regent College has introduced a new policy granting admitted students advanced standing with credit in limited circumstances.

HOW TO QUALIFY

Students interested in being considered for advanced standing with credit must begin an application for admission to Regent College at rgnt.net/apply. Students can indicate their interest in advanced standing with credit in the Personal Statement accompanying their application for admission or in an email to admissions@regent-college.edu.

CRITERIA

To qualify for advanced standing with credit, a student must demonstrate the following:

- Broad exposure to the humanities, including courses in biblical studies, the history of Christianity, and Christian theology.
- Graduation from an undergraduate degree program no more than 7 years prior to admission to Regent College, with a graduating GPA of at least 3.7 on a 4-point scale.
- A minimum grade of A- in a course or courses with content similar to that of specific introductory courses at Regent College.

CREDITS EARNED

Applicants from your school who meet these criteria may be granted advanced standing with credit up to the following maximum limits:

Master of Arts in Christian Studies	9	42
Master of Arts in Theological Studies	12	60
Master of Divinity	18	90
