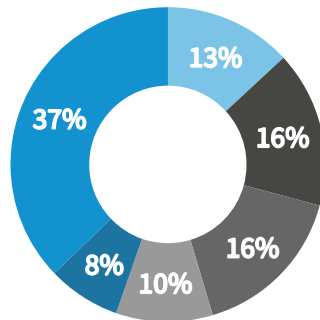

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

High school students must have five Grade 12 courses with an overall average of 60%+. Academic Grade 12 English must be one of the five courses. Of the four remaining courses, three must be standard courses and the fifth may be a non-standard course.

KING'S SCHOLARSHIPS & AWARDS

Each year King's awards approximately \$500,000 in scholarships and awards. Students can apply for competitive scholarships and bursaries through King's Scholarships & Awards Application, available online on February 1 for study in 2022/23. The **deadline to apply is March 31, 2022**. Approximately 40% of students who apply receive an award with an average value of \$1,500.

King's students are also automatically awarded scholarships based on their admission average: \$2,000 for 80-89%; \$3,000 for 90-100%.
