The Micah Centre at The King's University, in partnership with WorldRenew and the Northern Alberta Diaconal Conference, works with communities in Honduras to build clean water systems. For over 25 years, we have partnered in community building, mutual learning, prayer, financial support, and provision of labour to work toward a world in which everyone has access to clean, healthy drinking water. Each year, a group of King's students visits a project to help build a stage of the water project and to build friendships with our global neighbours in Honduras.

The Micah Centre will select a group of students to spend 2¹/₂ weeks learning and serving in southern Honduras with WorldRenew. Applications will be considered in the order received, according to merit. Priority may be given to students who are in their final year of study, who have not received previous Micah travel bursaries, and who are enrolled in the Micah Certificate program.

A non-refundable deposit will be due if your application is successful. The rest of the fees for the project – covering project costs and student travel/accommodation – will be due by April 16, 2024. Students are able to fundraise for these costs, and are expected to participate in group fundraising as part of their involvement in the project.
