### OUR FACILITY

We are located on 220 acres of rolling hills one hour west of Edmonton. We offer 6 day overnight camps for children and youth ages 6-17. Activities include archery, riflery, zipline and climbing wall, petting zoo, horsemanship, an escape bus, laser tag, and wide games. We run junior & intermediate camps out of our cabins on the main site and a tipi village and youth development programs for high school youth. All cabins have shower & bathroom facilities.

### Job Summary:

- This leadership position is responsible for all development, implementation and supervision of the Crew Youth Program. You will get the chance to disciple and be a role model to the youth while participating in a plethora of camp activities. See them grow as they learn to lead the campers from your example and leadership. As much as it is a job, it is a great camp ministry experience we look forward to provide to all of our staff
