

Ministry Assistant

Position Summary:

Ministry Assistants encourage individual and communal Christian spiritual growth on campus. As a member of the Student Life team, the Ministry Assistant will be an integral part of Christian outreach and ministry on campus. He or she may lead a small group, service projects, and help plan regular campus worship (857). Most importantly, the Ministry Assistant will walk alongside their fellow students as we all attempt to become more like Christ. The Ministry Assistant will work approximately 10 hours per week.

Qualifications for all Student Leader positions:

- Open and willing to serving within a Christian context
- Support the King's mission and vision as well as demonstrate a commitment to King's community values
- Maintain a current and cumulative GPA of 2.5 or above
- Registered in at least your second academic year at King's throughout term of position

Qualifications for the Ministry Assistant role:

- Excited about growing in their Christian Faith
- Passionate about developing strong interpersonal relationships and encouraging others in their faith
- Ability to communicate effectively and work well on a team
- Ability to balance commitments (school/social/work) well
- Ability to create enthusiasm around Student Life and/or Campus Ministry events

Responsibilities:

- Attend orientation to welcome incoming students to King's
- Attend weekly Ministry Assistant meetings
- Attend chapel and Worship 857
- Lead a discipleship small group focused on Scripture/book/activity in an area of personal interest
- Lead a service project each semester
- In collaboration with others, plan and lead 857 worship services
- Be an intentional presence on a floor in the residence tower
- Support others on the ministry team in their work.
- Stay current with COVID guidelines

Expectations for all Student Leader positions:

- Serve as a role model by demonstrating integrity inside and outside of the classroom
- Demonstrate ability to develop strong interpersonal relationships
- Set an example for what a successful student looks like by living with integrity, participating in activities throughout the year, and contributing to King's community life
- Demonstrate sensitivity toward diversity issues through friendship and advocacy for students.
- Have a working knowledge of and abide by the regulations, policies, and procedures of King's as described in the Student Handbook and Community Living Standards



Compensation:

- Ministry Assistants will be paid \$1900 divided semi-monthly for the duration of the contract. Payment is processed through King's payroll.
